Policy as per RRF Board of Directors:

- The record owner of each residential property at the Ranch at Roaring Fork may be issued an "Owner Identification Golf Pass". This pass is good for unlimited golf play for the owner, and immediate family members living within the owner's household.
- This pass will only be issued to the owner on record.
- Guests of owners must pay fees to play.
- Tenants of owner's must pay fees to play.
- Each unit will be issued only one pass
- Owners must have the owners identification on them at all time on the course

- Passes are seasonal, good for 2007 only. The course is scheduled to close October 22nd.
- Passes may be revoked for failure to comply with the Ranch at Roaring Fork Golf Course Rules and Etiquette, or inappropriate behavior as determined by the Ranch at Roaring Fork Golf Course management.
- Golf course conditions will change.
- Occasional course closures may occur for maintenance or events.
- Anyone using this golf pass voluntarily accepts the risks associated with golfing at the Ranch at Roaring Fork Golf Course (RRFGC). Users recognize that inherent and other hazards exist while participating in the sport. These risks include, but are not limited to: swinging clubs, rapidly moving golf balls, variations in surfaces, terrain features, ditches, ponds, water, drainages, weather phenomena, trees, maintenance equipment, and other golfers and their actions. These and other unspecified risks may present a risk of serious and/or fatal injury. It is the responsibility of the pass purchaser to inform all users of this pass of their acceptance of risks
- In consideration of using the RRFGC facilities, the purchaser and users of this pass agree to accept the risks of golfing and agree not to sue the Ranch at Roaring Fork Homeowner's Association, its members, contractors, or employees regardless of any negligence.

Golf Course Rules and Etiquette

Always show courtesy towards others and be aware that there are elements of risk involved in golfing that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the rules listed below and share with other golfers the responsibility for a great golfing experience.

- All golfers must check –in at Golf Shop prior to play.
- All golfers are responsible for the consequence of the ball that they hit.
- No non-golfing children are allowed on course.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Shirt and shoes required. Soft spikes or smooth soled shoes only.
- You must keep pace with group ahead, or allow faster players to play through.
- Five or bigger groups not allowed without prior approval from the Golf Shop attendant.
- Out of bounds (OB) unless on maintained turfgrass along left side of #1 through #5, and back of #4 and #5. Homeowner's yards on back side of #5, left side of #6 and #7 are OB. Left of tree-line on #8 and #9 is OB.
- Repair ball marks on greens.
- Replace divots on tees and approaches.
- Keep pull carts and golf bags 10 feet from greens and out of sand traps.
- Rake and smooth sand after playing from traps.
- No ball hunting in ponds. No swimming in ponds.
- No pets.
- No intoxication.
- No person shall engage in any activity unsafe to themselves or others.
